**Routes de France, Chardonnay 2021, Languedoc, France** 16 | 60

The first impression of this Chardonnay screams 'oak, flowers, peaches, vanilla'. On the palate, it's buttery, with plenty of tropical fruit and a hint of brioche.

**Villa Wolf, Pinot Gris 2021, Pfalz, Germany** 19 | 80

Light yellow, with juicy yet crispy aromas of pear, ripe apple, and some citrus. On the palate fresh acidity, dry, and some juiciness.

**Wolftrap, Viognier - Chenin Blanc 2021, Franschhoek, South Africa** 19 | 80

An enticing aroma of green apple and lemon along with notes of white flowers. The wine tastes a bit creamy and oaky on the palate with tons of rich flavors.

**Babich, Sauvignon Blanc 2022, Marlborough, New Zealand** 21 | 105

Aromas of tropical fruits and lime. Shows stone fruits with passionfruit, blackcurrant, and grapefruit on the palate.

**Fontanafredda, Gavi di Gavi 2022, Serralunga d'Alba, Italy** 110

The bouquet of this wine will have your mouth watering before the first sip. Very floral, citrus zest, and vanilla aromas. The wine is dry, full, and elegant.

**Tiefenbrunner, Pinot Grigio 2021, Südtirol, Italy** 110

This top-of-the-line Pinot Grigio has aromas of citrus, white blossoms, pears, apples, and meadow grass. There is a fresh, crisp minerality and a clear finish.

**El Jardin de Lucia, Albariño 2021, Rias Baixas, Spain** 135

This Albariño has an alluring aroma of jasmine and apricot with hints of citrus and white pepper. On the palate peach and more citrus.

**Chateau de Thauvenay, Sauvignon Blanc 2021, Sancerre, France** 135

Cool, fresh, vegetal, and delicate yeasty nose with very light yellow fruit notes as well as floral and chalky-mineral nuances.

**Quinta Belondrade Apolonia, Verdejo 2021, Castilla y Leon, Spain** 135

The little sister of the well-known Belondrade y Lurton. This Verdejo has soft notes of exotic fruit and floral aromas. A truly exceptional wine.

**Bernard Defaix, Chardonnay 2021, Chablis, France** 145

Plenty of minerality, mouth-watering, ripe stone fruits, and a waft of sea breeze. Classically structured and Chablis-level length.

# bubbles

**Gran Espanoso Brut Cava, Catalunya, Spain.** 19 | 80

This cava has a pale yellow color. Light brioche aroma with green fruity aromas like green apple.

**Bollinger Special Cuvee, Champagne, France.** 225

This favourite of 007 has lovely aromas of roasted apples and peaches. On the palate brioche, pear and fresh walnut.

# red

- Călușari, Pinot Noir 2021, Recaș, Romania** 17 | 75  
I hear you thinking, 'Wine from Romania?' Trust us. This pinot noir is fruit-forward with aromas of cherries and blackberries and a slight smokiness on the nose.
- La Linda, Syrah - Cabernet Sauvignon - Tannat 2020, Mendoza, Argentina** 17 | 75  
With a base of fruity and herbal cabernet, the roundness of syrah, and tannins of tannat, this wine will not disappoint.
- Moda Talamonti, Montepulciano 2021, Abruzzo, Italy** 20 | 90  
Typical purple hue from this Montepulciano, with lofty aromas of cherry, prunes, and raspberry.
- Zenato, Corvina - Corvinone - Rondinella, Valpolicella 2019, Italy** 110  
This beautifully balanced Valpolicella is always a good idea. On the nose delicate red fruit: wild berries, cherries, and spices. This wine has mild tannins.
- Gerard Bertrand Saint Victor, Pinot Noir 2021, Roussillon-Languedoc, France** 110  
A fruity and juicy pinot noir with a slight hint of pepper. Very soft tannins make for a beautifully structured wine. Notes of cherries and raspberries and a fruity aftertaste.
- Venta las Vacas, Tempranillo 2020, Ribera del Duero, Spain** 125  
Beautiful nose of soft fruit, and some floral notes. On the palate fruit expressions as well as some oak. Mature tannins and a long round finish.
- El Enemigo, Cabernet Franc 2019, Mendoza, Argentina** 145  
This beautifully structured wine shows oak, earthy, and tobacco aromas. With flavors of blackberry, black plums, and hints of smoke. If it's a wine with character you're looking for.
- Chateau L'Enclos, Merlot - Cabernet Sauvignon - Petit Verdot 2015, Pomerol, France** 190  
This right-bank Bordeaux is a beautiful display of how it leans towards Merlot with ripe red and black fruit characteristics; cherry, plums, cassis, and currants. Over the years the tannins have clearly softened.

# rosé

- L'égerie de Gallician, Grenache - Cinsault 2021, Provence, France** 19 | 80  
A beautifully dry and refreshing rose with floral aromas and notes of strawberry and a spiced aftertaste.
- Domaine Ott Clos Mireille, Grenache - Syrah - Cinsault 2021, Provence, France** 140  
By many considered as the benchmark rose from the Provence, this wine is exactly what you're looking for. Light pale pink in color, on the nose fresh fruit notes. On the palate citrusy aromas and some minerality.
